SUMMER A or C (A&B) 2012 HOUSING

COMPLETE THESE STEPS BETWEEN MARCH 2 – MARCH 23:

- STEP 1:** Login to housing portal (<http://my.housing.ufl.edu>) and select the "CONTRACT" link. Once there, select the term you want housing for (Summer A or C) and follow the prompts to submit your contract. It is important to ensure that you select the correct term in which you desire campus housing. Changes in the contract period may result in cancellation charges and a second advance rent payment for the new contract period.
- STEP 2:** Wait at least 24 hours for the charge to post online then make the online payment at <http://my.ufl.edu>, or print out the contract confirmation email and submit with payment to the Housing Office.
- STEP 3:** Between March 19 & March 23, return to housing portal (<http://my.housing.ufl.edu>) and select "ROOM SIGNUP" link to select your summer room. March 19 & 23 are "Same Room Sign-Up" days, where you may only select the room you currently occupy during the Spring 2012 Semester *if your current hall is open for both Summer A & B terms.*
- ROOM CHANGES:** You will be able to login March 24 - April 13 and make changes to your Summer A/C assignment until you have been billed for Summer A.

SIGN UP EARLY!!! Summer A/C room selection is 1st come, 1st serve basis, including single rooms and spaces in the Keys Complex. There is only a two-day window at the beginning of Summer A/C room sign up (March 19 to 23) where you are guaranteed the chance to stay in your current Spring 2012 room for the Summer, if your current space is open for the Summer term. The longer you wait to complete the process, the greater the chance of your preferred room, hall, or room type filling up.

SUMMER B 2011 only HOUSING

COMPLETE THESE STEPS BETWEEN MARCH 2 – MARCH 23:

- STEP 1:** Beginning on March 2, login to housing portal (<http://my.housing.ufl.edu>) and select the "CONTRACT" link. Once there, select the term you want housing for (Summer B) and follow the prompts to submit your contract. It is important to ensure that you select the correct term in which you desire campus housing. Changes in the contract period may result in cancellation charges and a second advance rent payment for the new contract period.
- STEP 2:** Wait at least 24 hours for the charge to post online then make the online payment at <http://my.ufl.edu>, or print out the contract confirmation email and submit with payment to the Housing Office.
- STEP 3:** Selecting your hall and room type preferences. You still must complete the online portion of the Residence Hall Contract fully (with hall and room type preferences), in case your preferred room is not available due to unforeseen maintenance, consolidation of floor/hall or other considerations. See rental rates to see list of anticipated Summer B residence halls. You may log back in to the housing portal and change your preferences using the "PREFERENCES" link any time through April 30. Room assignments will be may by assignments based on students preferences.

SUMMER A, B, & C 2012 HOUSING INFO

THINGS TO KNOW:

STUDENTS OCCUPYING DESIGNATED DISABLED ROOMS: Any student without a disability who is currently occupying a disabled room may not select or request the same room for the summer term as the space may be needed for a student with a disability. We will attempt to accommodate any summer student that we displace in this process with a similar room.

CONSOLIDATION: If vacancies occur on a given floor or hall, students may be required to move to a new room or hall assignment in order to make maximum use of our summer facilities.

I MISSED THE DEADLINES – CAN I STILL GET HOUSING? Log on to the housing portal and request to be placed on the waitlist. Summer Housing Contracts will continue to be offered as long as space is available. If you want to stay and/or store your belongings during the intersession between Spring and Summer A, you must complete your contract and select a room by April 30 at noon.

SUMMER DEFERMENT GUIDELINES: In order to defer the \$200 advance rent payment, you must be receiving at least \$1,400 in secured financial aid through the University's Financial Aid Office, excluding work study and fee waivers, for each summer term or provide documentation that you are receiving Social Security/Veteran's/Disability Benefits in the same amount at the time you request the deferment. Continuing students wishing to defer the \$200 advance rent payment must apply for the deferment at the main housing office and must have received a housing rent deferment for the Spring 2012 semester.

MY SUMMER TERM CHANGED – WHAT DO I DO? If your class schedule changes such that you are attending a different summer term(s) than you originally indicated, you **MUST** come to the Housing Office in person to have the term on your housing contract adjusted. Cancellation charges may apply.

WHEN CAN I MOVE IN? Information regarding move-in, availability for storage, and intersession housing will be emailed in a separate email to students who have contracted for the summer terms..

CANCELLATIONS

STUDENTS NOT ATTENDING SUMMER CLASSES: See [Terms and Conditions](#) of the contract for further details.

Summer A/C : if a student cancels their contract because their courses are not offered AND they provide us with a letter from their college or department on letterhead stating that the course is not offered, they will not be charged a cancellation charge as long as the cancellation occurs prior to opening day for summer A (May 10). If the student does not cancel their contract prior to opening day (May 10) AND they check into the residence halls, they will be charged a cancellation charge as well as prorated rent.

Summer B Only: if the student cancels their contract because their courses are not offered AND they provide us with a letter from their college or department on letterhead stating that the course is not offered, they will not be charged a cancellation charge as long as the cancellation occurs prior to opening day for summer B (June 27). If the student does not cancel their contract prior to opening day (June 27) AND they check into the residence halls, they will be charged a cancellation charges as prorated rent.

STUDENTS ATTENDING SUMMER CLASSES: Your Residence Hall Contract is a legally-binding contract. You **WILL NOT** be able to cancel your housing contract once it is signed and returned as long as you are registered for summer classes. Only students with written documentation of severe medical or financial hardship may appeal for release from their contract. You may only cancel if your appeal is approved. See Application for Contract Release form (available from your area Residence Director/Residence Life Coordinator) for more details.

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
